### **Miniature Pinschers**

A great entry with some top quality dogs to choose from and so pleasing to see a good number of promising puppies, must bode well for the breed.

#### MPD (7)

1. Brown's Hawksflight Black Russian. Headed a great class to start off with, this promising and smart young B/T boy is a lovely size and shape and scored highly on his pleasing hackney action. Attractive head with small dark eyes and neat ears. Good front, nicely laid shoulders and compact body. Good rear angulation and tail carriage. Came into his own on the move, really confident and sound, I was pleased to award him best puppy dog.
2. Neasby's Hawksflight Island Fox On Ulani. Slightly bigger red, again with a good hackney action and shown in super condition too. Lovely head with dark eyes and very well placed ears. Good front, cobby body and in super coat and condition. Just needs to settle a little but another full of type and showing much promise.

#### JD (2)

1. Colborne-Baber's Borneaways Alfred The Great. Smart smaller built B/T with good hackney movement. Attractive head and expression with very neat ears. Good front and shoulders, compact body, good topline and hind angulation and well set on tail. Shown in great coat and condition and moved out well.
2. Mitchell's Galkerah Aladdin Sane. Bigger built than winner, but still well balanced and a great showman too. Masculine head, could perhaps be a touch more refined. Shown in lovely condition and coat with well laid shoulders, deep chest, well ribbed back and a good topline. Moved out smartly.

#### YD (2,1abs)

1. Schneider & Park's Camalis Mr Magoo JW (Swed Imp). B/T boy in very fit muscular condition and in super coat too with rich tan markings. Good for size and outline with slightly sloping topline and good rear angulation. Head is more continental in type with slightly longer foreface, very dark eyes and good ear placement. Moved out well, would like a little more hackney action.

#### PGD (3)

1. Banton's Darkiss Smokin Aces. Super B/T boy who just had the edge on showmanship and more settled movement, although would have liked a touch more hackney action. Attractive head and expression, dark eyes and neat ears. Nice straight front, lovely size and overall square outline with good sweep of stifle. Moved out positively.
2. Griffiths' Rovilo's Amazing Mr Fox At Amious. Shaded red boy, slightly taller than winner but retains balance. Lovely head and expression with well-placed ears. Straight front, good topline with slight slope and good hind angulation. Shown in lovely coat and condition. Moved out very well, just needs to concentrate a little more, but a nice quality boy.

#### LD (9,2abs)

1. Mackie's Hawksflight He Who Dares. B/T, this young dog gave his all today and presents a most attractive and typical picture. Loved his size and shape. Fabulous head, dark eyes and small neat ears. Straight front, lovely topline with a gentle slope, well angulated behind and tail set on correctly. Well-marked coat and shown in fit gleaming condition. Moved out so well with such a lovely profile in particular, very pleased to award him the DCC, BOB and thrilled to see him take Toy group 4 in strong competition.
2. Ironside's Hawksflight If You Dare. Very similar comments apply and what a showman he is too. Gorgeous head, small dark eyes and neat ears. Straight front, deep chest, super topline

and tail set. He also moves out so well and shown in great coat and condition, it was very hard separating these two, nit picking really. I see from the catalogue that they are litter brothers, what a litter! Pleased to award him the RDCC.

3. French's Wolfberg Riders On The Storm

#### OD (7)

1. Smith's Tubize Hudson JW. Liked the size and compact shape of this quality B/T boy very much. Pleasing outline with a slightly sloping topline. Shown in gleaming coat and fit condition. Super head, very dark eyes and well placed ears. Good front, deep chest and well ribbed. Moved out well, would like a touch more hackney action, but a quality boy and a real showman too. Close up in the challenge just giving a little away in terms of maturity.
2. Harrison's Ch Trenson Flummadiddle ShCM. Super red dog full of breed type, lovely head and bright intelligent expression, with neat ears, would like a touch darker eye. Straight front, well laid shoulders, well ribbed back with slightly sloping topline giving a pleasing a typical outline. Moved out well with good action, and a willing and attentive showman.
3. Santoriello & Skelton's Ch Pinicio Jelly Beanie JW ShCM

#### VB (2,1abs)

1. Iveson's Ch Carive Polly Pocket Jw ShCM. What a lovely bitch, I can see why she holds her Ch title. At 8 years she belies her years. Lovely for size and shape with slightly sloping topline. Super head, small neat ears, and very dark eyes. Good front and shoulders, good depth of chest and nice sweep of stifle. Shown in lovely coat and condition and moves out well with good hackney action.

#### MPB (3)

1. Watts' Hawksflight White Russian At Estivals. Headed a quality class, just had the edge on her more collected movement. Lovely head, very dark eyes and small ears giving a keen expression. Good front, nice shoulders, good depth of chest and with the desired slightly sloping topline and nice sweep of stifle too. Shown in super coat and condition. Moves very well with a good hackney action, very happy to give her best puppy bitch and BPIB.
2. Scourfield's Epiphany Remembrance At Danton. Slightly finer built red bitch of lovely breed type and quality, just needs to settle but showing glimpses of super hackney movement. Pretty head, dark eyes and good ear placement. Pleasing straight front, nicely bodied for age with a slightly sloping topline giving a lovely shape. Going to be a very showy little girl.
3. Griffith's Hawksflight Midnight Kiss.

#### PB (1)

1. Goff's Dobenar Itz A Gift For Hufflepin. Neat little B/T girl with a pleasing outline. Pretty head, very dark eyes and neat ears, would like a little more strength to muzzle. Good front, deep chest, slightly sloping topline and nicely angulated behind. Moves out very well with lovely hackney action, shown in nice coat and condition too.

#### JB (4,1abs)

1. Whetter's Tubize Macy At Mandolais. Headed a really nice class of promising young ladies. Scored here for her maturity and slightly more substance at this stage. Lovely overall shape and outline. Pretty head, dark eyes and good ear set. Good front and topline, tail set on well. Moved out well, would like a touch more bend at wrist to give more pronounced hackney.
2. French's Tubize Liberty With Wolfberg. Slightly smaller B/T sister to winner and again very nice outline and balanced appearance. Very pretty head, dark eye and good ears. Lovely front and topline. Moves out positively, again would ideally like a more pronounced hackney action. Shown in lovely coat and condition.

#### YB (3)

1. Santoriello & Skelton's Tubize Manhattan By Pinicio. Yet another sister from this super litter, probably the most mature of them at the moment. Loved her size and shapely outline with

slightly sloping topline and compact shape. Pretty head, dark eyes and good ear placement. Good legs and feet, deep chest, well ribbed and good hind angulation too. Shown in super coat and condition. Such an attentive showgirl. Moves out well with good reach, still could do with a touch more hackney but her overall qualities won her the RBCC.

2. Whetter's Tubize Macy At Mandolais. See notes for Junior, not quite the forward reach on the move as her litter sister standing first.
3. Williams-Wegmann's Bellpins Miss Cilla Black For Essvana

PGB (1)

1. Watts' Estivals Koko Chanel. B/T girl, well bodied for her age, just appears a touch longer than square. Shown in super condition with gleaming coat and great muscle tone. Pleasing head shape with very dark eyes, ears could be a little neater. Good topline and angulated hindquarters, tail set on well. Moves out positively with good reach.

LB (5,2abs)

1. Dunn's Collypins Let It Be Me At Valetta. Lovely quality B/T girl, liked her size and shape very much with gently sloping topline. Nice head and expression, dark eyes and good ear placement. Straight front, short and cobby body with nice sweep of stifle and tail set on well. Moves out well with quite a good hackney action.
2. Chapman's Carive Black Is Back At Vickstock JW. Another lovely bitch of a pleasing size and compact shape. Feminine head with dark eyes and good ear placement giving a keen expression. Good front, shapely body with slightly sloping topline, good sweep of stifle and tail set on well. Moves out with good reach, not quite such good hackney as winner.
3. Allen's Adurus Love In The Mist With Jaycroft

OB (8)

A strong class and even those unplaced could another day quite easily have been in the cards

1. Wilkinson's Jaycroft Jessie Jay With Keljantzi JW. This quality B/T girl caught my eye as soon as she entered the ring, loved her square and compact outline with her slightly sloping topline giving a super profile. Beautifully feminine head, small neat ears and very dark eyes giving a bright intelligent expression. Straight front, good shoulders and well angulated behind. Shown in gleaming coat and fit condition. On the move she has the desired hackney movement and shows herself off to great advantage. More than happy to award her the BCC and BOS.
2. Smith & Coull's CH Katare's Mystery Delicious Vinletty (Swed Imp). Slightly different head type to winner and playing her handler up a bit today. Feminine head, slightly more continental in type, neat ears and dark eyes giving a keen expression. Good neck and shoulders, good topline with slight slope, well angulated hindquarters and tail set on well. Moves out very smartly with some hackney action, Shown in super coat and fit hard condition.
